Landscape from landscape: A painting inspired by the creatiive elemental energy of the landscape, made from natural and traditional materials found in the landscape. From the series Red Heart Summer Fire by artist Kerry Stevens.

These compositions describe the constantly changing elemental forces of the planet and will last for generations. The materials are poured onto birch panels in layers of shellac, wax, and natural pigments. Some panels have additional mark making from ink drawing or traces of smoke, contributing to their spontaneous and essential nature. They will last forr generations.

Each piece is totally unique, created with techniques the artist developed living and working in New York City and Venice, Italy.

Other multi-panel configurations and sizes also available upon inquiry.

Notes:

Each piece has raw edges. Basic hanging hardware installed. Shipping costs and timing will be determined based on destination.
